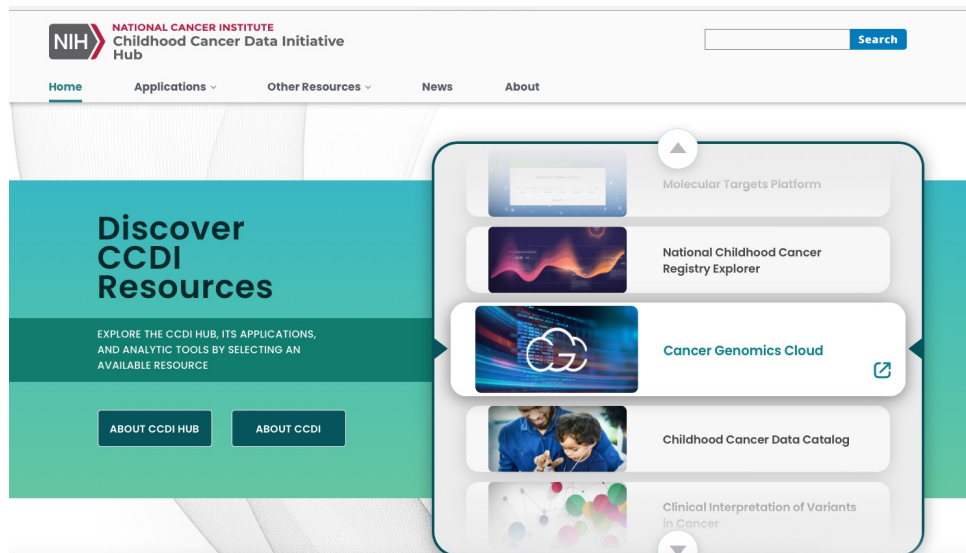

Overview of CCDI Hub & Catalog

CCDI Hub



- The CCDI Hub is an entry point for researchers, data scientists, and citizen scientists looking to use and connect with CCDI-related data
- It provides information and direct links to CCDI platforms, tools, and resources, along with additional technical information
- CCDI platforms and tools (discussed in upcoming slides) bring together data and allow us to use these data in new ways

CCDI Childhood Cancer Data Catalog

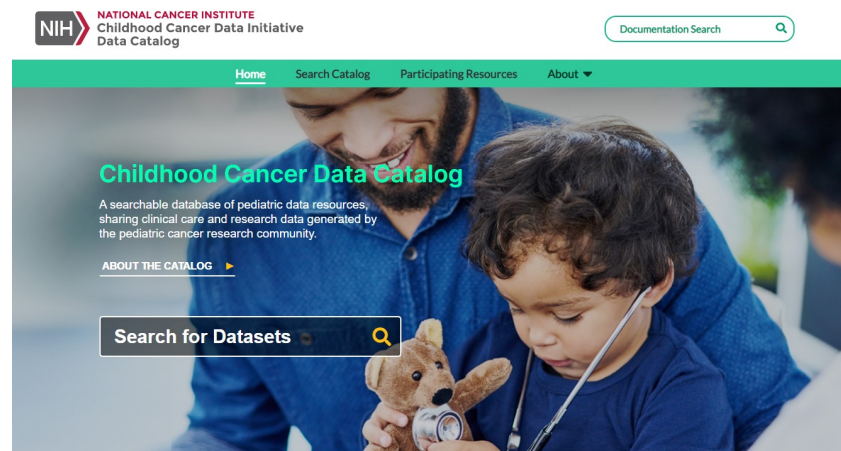


What it is:

- An inventory of childhood cancer resources
- Includes repositories, registries, data commons, websites, and catalogs that manage and refer to data
- Each resource page includes a summary description and links to access the data

What it does:

- Makes it easier for researchers to find data that could help them with their work

CCDI Childhood Cancer Data Catalog

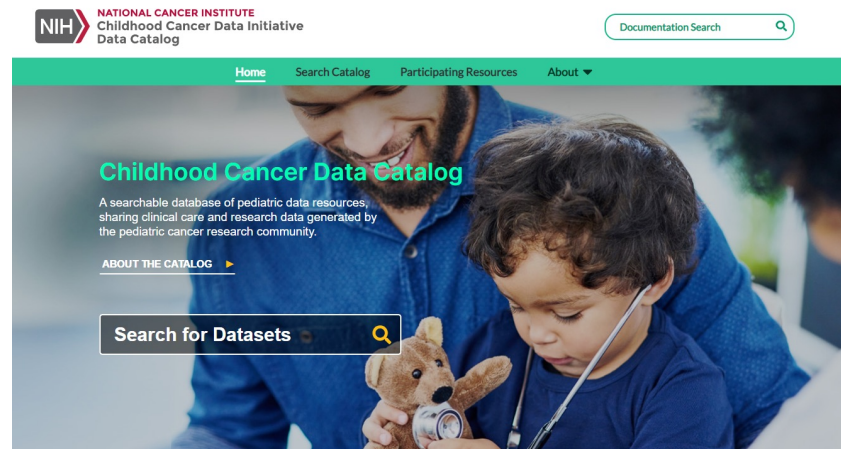


The data include:

- 237 data sets from 47 resources
- Including data from:
 - Cell lines
 - Clinical
 - Epidemiologic
 - Genomics & other –omics
 - Imaging
 - Xenograft

CCDI data:

- Links to 8 CCDI data sets
 - Including the Molecular Characterization Initiative (MCI)
